	<p>His Authority and Teachings (Vol.3)</p> <p>This part focusses on the most important teachings of Jesus, such as the sermon on the mount which covers all parts of life, emphasising on the law of love and forgiveness. It also discusses some of His miracles and the choosing of His disciples.</p>
	<p>His Great Miracles (Vol.4)</p> <p>The author mentions in this part some of Jesus' teachings and parables, emphasising on what these symbolize in the life of people, especially the parables. In addition to this, he mentions some of the miracles that Jesus did and the sending of His twelve disciples to preach the Good News to the gentiles.</p>
	<p>His Essence and Discipleship Principles (Vol.5)</p> <p>This part contains an exact and precise discussion of the following points: The essence of Christ's personality, the testimony of heaven to Him, His authority, and His appearance on the mount of transfiguration in His heavenly glory. It also discusses the conditions for following Jesus and how to avoid stumbling blocks. Some of Christ's teachings and miracles are mentioned too.</p>
	<p>His Entrance into Jerusalem (Vol.6)</p> <p>The author mentions in this part Christ's encounters and discourses. When Jesus Christ entered Jerusalem</p>



Jesus mourned over the fate of the city and prophesied about its destruction and future events too. Christ foretold the disciples about His crucifixion and encouraged them, especially Peter, and instituted the Holy Communion.</p>
	<p><u>His Death and Glorious Ressurrection (Vol.7)</u> The author mentions in this last part of the book the following points: Arrest of Christ, the trial by Jewish Elders and High Priests and by the Roman Governor. He also mentions Christ's crucifixion, death, resurrection, the post-resurrectional appearances of Christ and His ascension to heaven.</p>

The author divided his exposition of the parables into three parts, which contain all details of what is intended to be taught and clarified as follows: 1- The</p>

4. Miracles of Christ (sermons on Jesus' 28 miracles) by Menes Abdul Noor





9. Behold, Blessed Is the Man Whom God Rebukes! (Job) by Iskander Jadeed



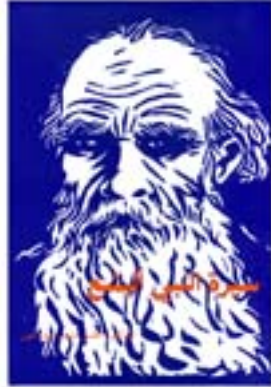
12. David and Solomon by Menes Abdul Noor

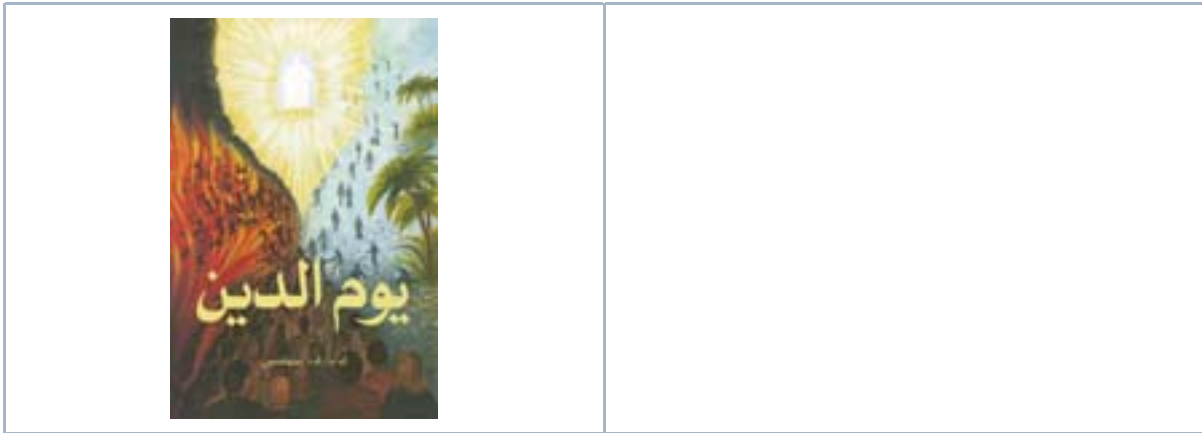

Another question that is answered in this booklet is: "I know that God created the world, and that He is love and good. But where did evil come from, and what does it mean?"

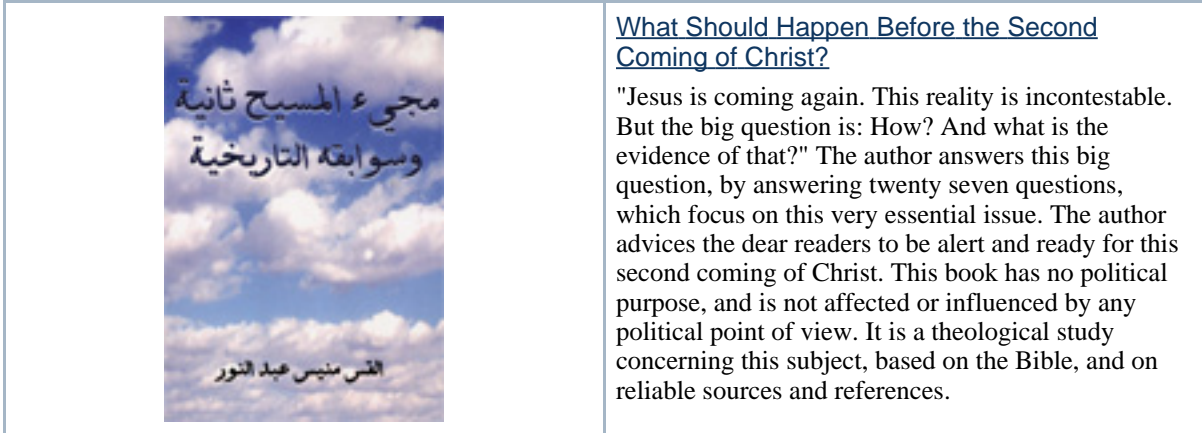
16. The Day of Judgment by K.H. Stevenson

20. Marriage in Christian Life by John Nour

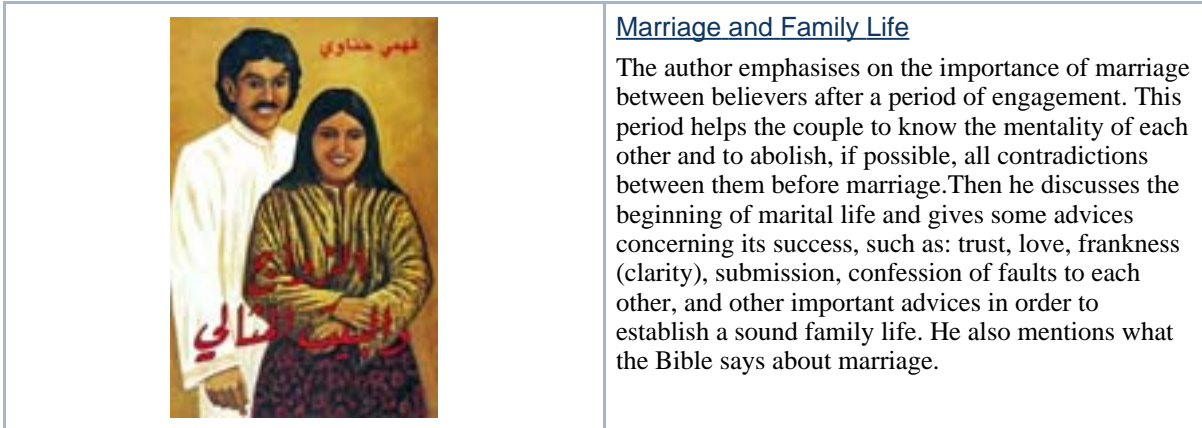

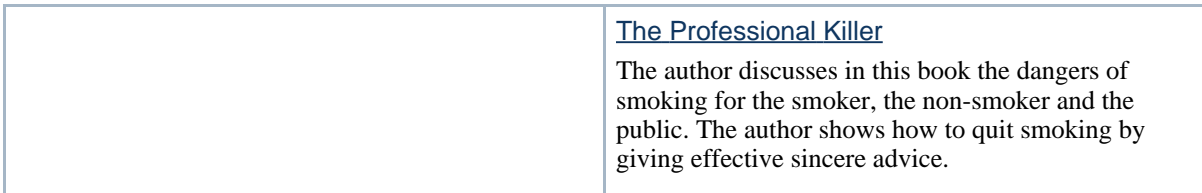
21. Marriage and Family Life by Fahmi Hannawi
